## INTRACLE INT

## Read John 2:1-11. 1. Today, many claim that the miracles we read about in Scripture do not take place today. Do you agree or disagree with this claim? Why? How might we miss the miracles God performs in our world on a daily basis? 2. Why do you think this was Jesus' first miracle? What does this miracle reveal to us about Jesus? 3. Every miracle Jesus performed on earth was only a taste of what we will experience in heaven. How does the hope of heaven empower you to live today? How can we, as believers, bring a piece of heaven into our world right now?

## Read John 5:1-15.

4. At the end of this story, Jesus asked the healed man to turn away from a life of sin. Why did he do this? Why is Jesus concerned with healing both the body and the soul?

5. Imagine if Jesus asked you the question we see in this story: "Do you want to get well?" What would that mean to you? How do you need to experience the healing of Jesus in your life?

6. Why did Jesus wait instead of rushing to Bethany to heal Lazarus? Why did Jesus say that raising Lazarus back to life would reveal God's glory? What do you think Jesus was trying to show us by raising Lazarus from the dead?
7. How do you identify with the pain of the characters in this story? How have you felt the grief of Marand Martha? How does it feel knowing that Jesus sees our pain and weeps in response to it?
8. How have you personally seen the power of God at work in this world? How have you or a loved on witnessed what God can do?
